Welcome to Redlands Camera Club

We hope the following information will give you an insight to our club's activities and we look forward to your participation.

Redlands Camera Club was formed in 2002 and welcomes photographers at all levels, from beginner to advanced, interested in any aspect of photography.

We encourage the development of photographic skills and artistic creativity through lectures, workshops, competitions and other club activities. We also organise field trips throughout the year.

Our members are friendly enthusiasts who are willing to share their knowledge and enjoy meeting people with similar interests. Above all we like to have fun with our photography!

Meetings

- The club meets on the first and third Monday of each month (except for the Christmas break). We do not meet every fortnight, as some months have 5 Mondays. Meetings start at 7.30pm and include supper (usually mid way through the meeting to enable a forum for further discussion among members).
- The first meeting of each month is normally a judging of a club competition and is usually judged by a PSQ (Photographic Society of Queensland) accredited judge. Judging is done in a constructive manner and is an ideal way to improve your skills with the judge giving comments on each entry.

Competitions

- The Club conducts Print and Projected Image Competitions most months of the year. These Competitions will be either a set subject or an Open section each month. Dates are outlined in the Club Calendar.
- Competition subjects are found in the Club's Calendar. This is available on the Club's website: www.redlandscameraclub.org.au.
- The second meeting (on the third Monday of the month) is usually a presentation or lecture by a guest speaker, or a practical night (eg taking of portraits). The Club also holds an annual Master Series of Speakers, which is sponsored by the Community Bank of Victoria Point. We bring in experts from around Australia & New Zealand to lecture on a variety of topics. These nights usually involve a slightly higher fee.

Exhibitions

- The Club holds the Redlands Exhibition of Photography most years. Entries are restricted to **Club Members and Redland City Residents**.
- The Club may also hold the Redlands **National** Photographic Exhibition which is run under the auspices of the APS. Entries come from around Australia and internationally.

Membership

- A Membership Handbook is provided to each person on joining. This booklet contains relevant information on how to participate in the various Club activities. It also includes definitions used for the various sections of our competitions and exhibitions.
- In addition to a Club Name Badge you will also be given a Membership number which is used to identify entries in the club competitions.
- Annual Fees, due for renewal on the 1st January of each year, are:
 - Annual Membership (Jan to Dec) \$40.00 (Family/Joint \$60)
 - Half Year (July to Dec) \$30.00 (Family/Joint \$45)*Family is deemed to comprise a maximum of 2 adults over 18 years of age and related minors.*
- A fee of \$3.00 per general meeting also applies to cover incidentals such as supper and Judges'/Presenters' travel costs. Membership fees are used to purchase capital items and to pay Club affiliation fees. An additional fee is charged for each of the Victoria Point Community Bank Master Series Presentations.
- Regular Workshops on a variety of topics from Basic Digital Photography to post processing skills/techniques are run for Financial Members.

We issue a Newsletter each month, which contains up-to-date information. The Redlands Camera Club is affiliated with the Australian Photographic Society (APS) and The Photographic Society of Queensland (PSQ).
